ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Harbor Pointe Credit Union Non-Traditional Scholarship

The following are guidelines for applying for a Harbor Pointe Credit Union Scholarship.

To be eligible, each applicant must have the following:

- ✓ A current HPCU member or become a HPCU member <u>by application deadline</u> to be considered for a scholarship.
- √ High School Diploma or GED
- ✓ Applicants may have had family, work, or military responsibilities as well as other life circumstances which kept them from pursuing further education.

Application is made by submitting the following information:

- ✓ Completed application form and responses to questions
- ✓ Copy of DD214, if applicable
- ✓ One written letter of recommendation from an employer or other non-related adult

The Scholarship Selection Committee may, at its discretion, consider special cases that do not fit the criteria set forth above.

One non-renewable scholarship award in the amount of \$2,000 will be awarded.

Applications must be received no later than **January 31st, 2025.** Applications can be returned to:

Recipient must be enrolled in a post-secondary educational institution within six months of notification of award.

Completed applications and all supporting documentation, including recommendation letter, must be postmarked, hand-delivered, or emailed by the deadline listed on the application. Late entries will not be considered. Applicant must have a Harbor Pointe Credit Union membership account upon applying and to be eligible for scholarship. Harbor Pointe Credit Union Board members, employees and their immediate family are excluded from participating in the HPCU scholarship program.
