Monthly board meetings are held to set policies and decide the long range direction of the credit union.



Cash incentive may be reversed if new account is closed within the first 6 months. Cash award is subject to all applicable taxes, which are the responsibility of the member who may receive a 1099 form. Harbor Pointe Credit Union reserves the right to cap member reward contributions at \$100 per household to preserve program integrity and provide multiple households the opportunity to participate. # QUICKLY ERASE A CREDIT CARD PURCHASE WITH YOUR SCORECARD POINTS!

#### Visa® & ScoreCard

Did you know you can use your HPCU Visa® credit card Scorecard points to pay for purchases you have made on your credit card?



20,000 points is worth \$20 and is the minimum you can use to erase a previous purchase balance, and \$1,000 is the maximum you can erase using your ScoreCard points.

#### Tips for Accessing and Redeeming Your ScoreCard Points

- **1.** Log into Visa Online from our website hpcu.us
- **2.** This will log you in to eZCard to view your Visa card balance, see transactions, make payments sign up for eStatements for your card and more.
- **3.** There is also a "View Rewards" button in the eZcard site which will take you directly to the ScoreCard rewards page.
- **4.** Once in ScoreCard click on the Shop Rewards drop down menu, there you will select Redeem to Erase option.
- **5.** Click on Go to Transactions to pull up your Visa purchase history. From here you can select one of your Visa transactions to Erase.
- **6.** Enter how many points you would like to use (remember 20,000 points is the minimum) and select the Erase button.

That's it! You will see a credit on Visa card for the amount you selected within a few days.
